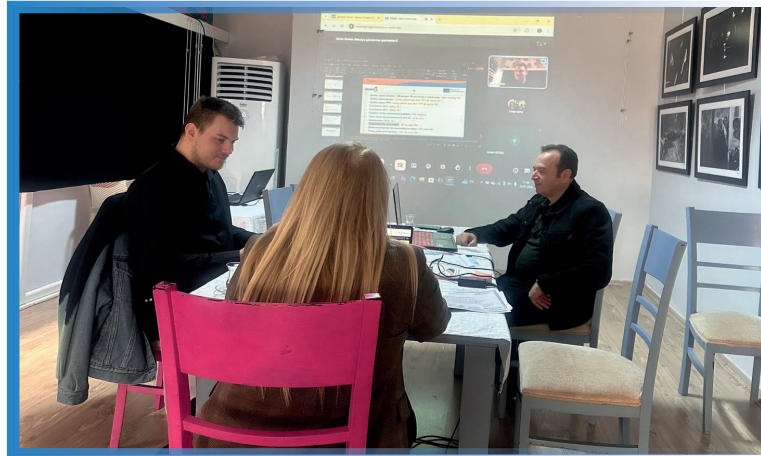

HYBREDU is a Cooperation Partnership in Adult Education, co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the EU. The project, implemented by Asociación Deses 3 (Spain), Formative Footprint (Spain), Smart Nest (Latvia), Sveronis I. & SIA O.E. (Greece), and Dalya (Türkiye), aims to equip adult educators with the skills and tools necessary to integrate digital competences into their teaching practices. Through a combination of online courses, practical activity kits, and innovative learning methodologies, the project will empower adult educators to enhance their digital creativity and teaching methods, benefiting both educators and adult learners in a hybrid educational environment.

## 3rd Transnational Project Meeting in Adana, Türkiye

The third Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) of the HYBREDU project was successfully held in **Adana, Türkiye, on January 23, 2026**, hosted by **DALYA AJANS**. The meeting brought together representatives of all partner organisations, both onsite and online, providing a valuable opportunity to review the overall progress of the project and coordinate the final implementation phase.

During the meeting, partners reviewed the achievements reached so far and discussed the final steps towards the completion of the project. Particular attention was given to ensuring the quality of the project outputs and aligning all partners for the upcoming piloting phase.



### Key Outcomes of the Meeting

The consortium confirmed the successful completion of the main project results and established a shared understanding of the next steps. Particular focus was placed on final improvements, user engagement, and the practical applicability of the developed materials.

Partners also exchanged feedback on the learning content and explored ways to enhance accessibility and interactivity, including the use of multimedia tools and innovative digital approaches. The meeting played a key role in strengthening cooperation and ensuring a smooth transition into the final phase of the project.

## Finalisation of Project Outputs

The HYBREDU consortium has successfully finalised its main project outputs. The **HYBREDU Online Course (WP2)** has been developed as a comprehensive training programme designed for adult educators, supporting them in improving their digital and AI competences and integrating innovative approaches into their teaching practices.

At the same time, the **Practical Activities (WP3)** have also been completed. These activities are designed to be implemented by educators in their daily work with adult learners, promoting active participation, creativity, and engagement in online, onsite, and hybrid learning environments.

Together, these outputs form a flexible and innovative learning framework that effectively bridges theory and practice.



## Start of the Piloting Phase

Following the completion of the development phase, the project has now entered **the piloting stage (WP4)**. This phase focuses on testing and validating the developed materials in real educational contexts across all partner countries.

Adult educators will engage with the online course while implementing the practical activities with adult learners. The piloting process includes pre-assessment, implementation, and post-assessment stages, enabling partners to evaluate the effectiveness, usability, and impact of the project results.

The feedback collected during this phase will be essential for refining the materials and ensuring their quality and relevance.



## Ensuring Quality and Impact

The piloting phase plays a key role in ensuring that the **HYBREDU results** are practical, user-friendly, and adaptable to different educational contexts. By involving both educators and learners, the project ensures a comprehensive evaluation process based on real needs and experiences.

This approach strengthens the sustainability and transferability of the project results, allowing them to be effectively used beyond the project duration.



## Next Steps



In the coming months, partners will implement pilot activities, collect and analyse feedback, and finalise the project results accordingly. The final phase will also focus on dissemination activities to ensure a wider reach and impact across the adult education sector.

HYBREDU continues to support adult educators in adapting to the evolving digital landscape and integrating innovative, hybrid approaches into their teaching practices.
